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1. Context

EGS started from the need to involve local communities in tackling energy issues and improving energy efficiency. The main actor contributing to involve a whole community and at the same time training the younger generations is the school, and more specifically high-schools. The project focuses on 4 main levels: developing new educational contents for pupils; teachers training; involvement of the local productive sector (SMEs); and governance. EGS created a network of 13 bottom-up school for involving families, local Administrations, SMEs, training institutions, environmental and energy agencies, public and private financial actors and all relevant stakeholders in 10 different countries.

The main outputs are: an energy manifesto for schools; energy management systems and audits in schools; training for pupils and teachers; and a collection of at least 39 new energy projects out of which each school forum will implement one pilot activity that will be monitored and evaluated during the project life.

2. Network Enlargement

The project aimed also at enlarging the network of schools and stakeholders. This 'enlargement' was generally sealed with the signature of the EGS Manifesto for energy efficiency in schools.

Nevertheless, in some cases EGS engaged and created synergies with existing projects or with organisations which wanted to commit on a more formal level.

For this type of situations, a template 'International cooperation agreement' was prepared. It was agreed among the partners that each project partner would be allowed to sign the agreement in the name of the EGS partnership, whenever a good opportunity at national or European level araised.

The project partners were also free to adapt the template according to the specific needs.

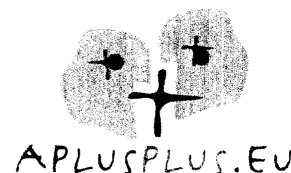
3. Signed agreements
